battalich automatic retransmission stations at Nui Chua Chan and Nui Ba Den wer difficult to resupply with electronic and communication equipment. Reasons wer The 185th Maintenance En, which is the battalion direct support in electronic and communication equipment, underwent a shortage of manpower. This resulted in a slow return rate of kT-524; and other equipment. The helicopter being the only mode of transportation to the relay sites, the cut in authorized blade time for the battalion made it difficult to get to the relay sites when it was necessary. Much of the reporting period being in the rainy season presented another problem for getting equipment and mail to the relay sites. The ecmmunication system for Castle Sector in the Fhu Loi Post perimeter was a problem to maintain. The berm of Castle Sector being reshaped by Engineer Support often resulted in broken wire lines and cables. The 26 pair cable that was installed in the last reporting period on the bunker line was old cable. As a result this brought about cross talk and multiple drops on the switchboard in the command bunker. In general communciation was unreliable. To correct this problem spiral four and le pair cable has been installed. Communication reliability and efficiency has greatly improved.

Medcap visits were made sporodically at Phu Cuong in conjunction with the 3/17 Cav and the 2/32 Arty. In addition, the battalion aid station has an open door policy to all Viscourses.
